There are many different ways in which a student can contribute, such as working for a charity, helping run a lunchtime club for younger students, supporting younger students through paired reading, lesson assistance or helping to run a homework club. These opportunities provide valuable experiences which can enhance a student's CV, broaden ambitions and help increase confidence and the skills of leadership and organisation.
