Changes to Numeracy and Literacy Professional Skills Tests for any Teaching QTS based courses

- 1) Candidates will have unlimited attempts to achieve a test pass.
 - 2) All candidates will be able to book 3 tests per subject (Literacy & Numeracy) free of charge. A charge will be applied from the fourth test attempt per subject.
 - 3) The 2-year lockout period will be removed; candidates previously locked out will be able to book tests for both subjects.

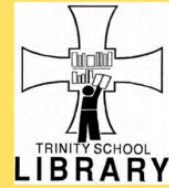

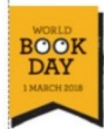
