Maurice George Trousdell

Killed in Belgium by bomb dropped from an aircraft (a rare event in WWI)
6 August 1917

Thomas Edward Thomlinson

Died of heart failure - Thomas holds the distinction of being our oldest casualty at 47 - he was employed acquiring horses for the army here in the UK.
8 August 1917

John Mitchell Mackay

Killed in Ypres, Belgium
10 August 1917

William Glaister Irving

Mercantile Marine. His ship, SS Sycamore, was torpedoed 125 miles off the coast of Ireland.
