Re: French/Spanish Student Booklets

We are very much looking forward to your child being as successful as they can in their language learning as they begin their GCSE. It would be very beneficial that your child attends each language lesson with a dictionary, which would support their learning. These can be purchased in most book shops or online and ideally should have a verb section.

The new GCSE demands are all based on a final end of course examinations in May/June 2019 and therefore, your child will be asked to recall information from the two year course. With this in mind for each Module of the course we have devised a booklet that covers the vocabulary, grammar and style of question that may be asked in the final examination. These booklets will be available to students to print or save electronically at home. They will form revision for the two years as well as providing them with the outline of the course as we move from topic to topic. They will feel familiar to the booklets in Year 9 and your child should feel encouraged that they already have been working with translations/photo cards and are used to regular vocabulary tests. It will provide grammar clarification and explanations for the demands of each module.
