Dear Parents/Carers

As you will be aware, all Year 9 students are undertaking the KS3 Diploma this year and have recently had an assembly to inform them of the next stage in the process – their extra-curricular participation.

Students were reminded about the standards that we would be looking at, and what they needed to do to achieve the different diploma standards. The categories being used for the diploma are:

- 1 Attendance
- 2 Punctuality
- 3 Achievement Points
- 4 Behaviour Points
- 5 Academic Progress
- 6 Extra-Curricular Participation

During the Spring term students received a 'snap shot' of where they were up to in terms of their diploma standard and have been working with their form tutors to try and set targets for improvements to move towards the next diploma standard – Credit, Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum – they have engaged very positively with this and have shown great determination to succeed.

They have also recently been issued an evidence sheet (see attached) to use to gather signatures to show their extra-curricular participation from whoever runs or organises the activity. This could be **ANY** club, team, group or volunteer work that they have participated in this year, outside of school hours eg sports clubs, cadets, theatre groups - returns of these forms should come to main reception by **Friday 16 June**.

We are proud to celebrate the success of our students and their achievements in the KS3 Diploma by inviting those who have achieved highly to an **Awards Evening on Monday 17 July 2017**. This is a chance for us to celebrate everything they have achieved so far at Trinity School and as they prepare for the demands of the KS4 curriculum and GCSE study.

Further details and invitations to this event will be sent to parent/carers following the final diploma standard being awarded at the start of July.
