**Re: Instrumental Tuition Arrangements for Year 7 New Starters in September 2019
Trial instruments and Endangered Instruments**

Payment Options and Information for Instruments

As your child has expressed an interest in taking instrumental tuition during the academic year 2019/20, I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for charging for music tuition from September 2019. There has been a slight increase in the cost of providing music lessons to students for the coming year. The Governing Body has decided not to pass this increase onto you this year, however, they will review this again for the next academic year 2020/21.

As an incentive to students, certain instruments will be offered on a free trial period to the end of September and this includes some Endangered Instruments which are being subsidised by Cumbria County Council. Should a student continue to receive lessons after the trial period we will only charge for 31 weeks tuition – see attached form to choose an instrument.

There will be 39 weeks in this school year, however, to allow for the trial period, inset days and the occasional missed lesson due to staff absences/school activities we will only charge for 31 lessons. The fees charged for the half hour Individual Lesson will be £20.00 and a Group Lesson will be £10.00. This means that for the academic year a student taking individual lessons will pay £620.00 overall and a student taking group lessons will pay £310.00

For Endangered Instruments the fees charged for the half hour Individual Lesson will be £18.25 and a Group Lesson will be £9.10. This means that for the academic year a student taking individual lessons will pay £565.75 overall and a student taking group lessons will pay £282.10.

The School's preferred method of payment is by monthly instalment either by standing order or via ParentPay. We would ask that the fees are paid in full by 30 June 2020 and this can be achieved by paying 9 equal payments, with the first payment being made before the end of October 2019.

For both instrumental options please complete the attached Forms which show the instruments available for the trial period and return them to the Finance office by 27 September 2019: use your child's name as your reference when setting up the standing order so that we can cross reference your payment easily. (Guitar lessons are not available for the trial period- there is a separate arrangement letter for Guitar lessons)

Your payments will be recorded, and regular statements will be issued to enable you to reconcile payments made against the Music Fees invoice which will be sent to you during the Autumn Term. You can also pay using your credit/debit card either via ParentPay or by phoning the Finance office on 01228 403560 (once the students ParentPay account has been activated). Payments by cash and cheque are acceptable and should be handed into the Student Reception: cheques should be made payable to 'Trinity School'. (Note: Fees are required to be paid in full by 30 June 2020).

The Music tutor will keep a register and a refund or credit note will only be issued at the end of the school year for valid absences. Valid reasons for absence are: teacher absence, school trips, exam leave, and long term illness. Total number of lessons received must be less than 31 as explained above. Lessons missed because of unforeseen circumstances, such as an occasional day's illness **will** be charged for. Please note that students will not be allowed to continue with lessons if payments are not received promptly. Should a student wish to stop taking lessons we require 4 weeks paid notice and confirmation in writing.



Arrangements for Keyboard/Piano, Violin, Singing and Drums 2019/20.

The Peripatetic teachers will be charging and collecting the fees for their particular lessons, therefore the Finance Office will not be involved with these. Parent/Carers will receive information directly from them at the start of September.

All students are required to come to the Music Department to check the dates and times of their lesson, staff are always on hand to help with this.
