The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.
- Adhere to the current guidance set out by the government as much as we reasonably can.
- Ensure high levels of hygiene and cleaning throughout the school buildings.
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs.
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19.
- Encourage twice weekly testing of staff and students.
- Follow the government and health authority guidance if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' have tested positive for COVID-19.
- Keep you well informed of the school's procedures during the pandemic through school comms, newsletters, text, email and the school website.
- Develop a clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for students as set out in the COVID Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement.
- Maintain our high level of pastoral care and safeguarding.
- Have contingency plans for every eventuality.
- Follow the current government guidance on self-isolation.

Parent

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- **If my child, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school and will notify school, by telephone, promptly.**
- I will ensure that my child brings the correct equipment to school on a daily basis, including hand sanitiser.
- I will encourage my child to socialise with a consistent group of friends.
- I will get in touch if I am concerned about my child's wellbeing.
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I will keep my contact details up to date.
- If my child's behaviour is deemed unsafe, I will support the school's recommendations for improving the situation.
- I will provide a face covering if required during local restrictions, for example, and make sure my child understands the rules for removing, storing and washing it.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- I understand that, should school be unable to provide safe staffing ratios or a safe environment as outlined in our risk assessment, school may need to close at short notice in line with Public Health advice.
- I understand that the school is unable to remove all risks relating to the spread of COVID-19.
- I will follow the instructions set out in this agreement as well as any additional instructions sent home via letter or email.

Student

I will do my best to follow the school's Covid specific behaviours:

- No chewing gum.
- No touching.
- 2m rule where adults and students wish – be thoughtful.
- Stay in your friendship groups, avoid mixing too widely.
- Bring your own equipment – no sharing!
- Stay out of the teacher zone, unless invited in.
- Stay in your seating plan and seat.
- No wandering - class, corridors, school.
- Obey all instructions from staff or on signs.
- Wash your hands, use sanitizer.
- Catch it, kill it, bin it.
- Stay home if ill with symptoms and get a test.
- If you feel ill in school, tell someone.
- No litter, bin it!

Main Symptoms

The main symptoms of Coronavirus are:

- **high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature);
- **new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual);
- **loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.



If a child presents with **any** Coronavirus symptoms, however mild, the child will be sent home.

By sending your child to Trinity School, we will presume consent to this agreement and that you have agreed to follow government guidance on staying alert and safe.
