TRINITY GREENS - 2024

TRINITY SCHOOLS NEW GARDENING CLUB, NOW CALLED TRINITY GREENS, HAS BEEN BUSY THROUGH THE AUTUMN AND WINTER MONTHS, 2022/2023

MEETING AFTER SCHOOL ON A TUESDAY, WE HAVE BEEN COMING UP WITH DESIGNS FOR THE 'MEMORY GARDEN', LOOKING AT AREAS WE CAN PLANT UP, AND MAKING PLANS TO CREATE A WILDLIFE AREA, MORE ABOUT THIS LATER IN THE AUTUMN TERM.

DURING 2023, WE HAVE BEEN COLLECTING OLD GARDENING BOOKS TO HELP TO RESEARCH PLANTS, LEARN ABOUT GROWING VEGETABLES, HOW TO BE SUCCESSFUL AT CONTAINER GARDENING AND HOW TO MAKE A SMALL POND TO ATTRACT WILDLIFE INTO THE GARDEN.
