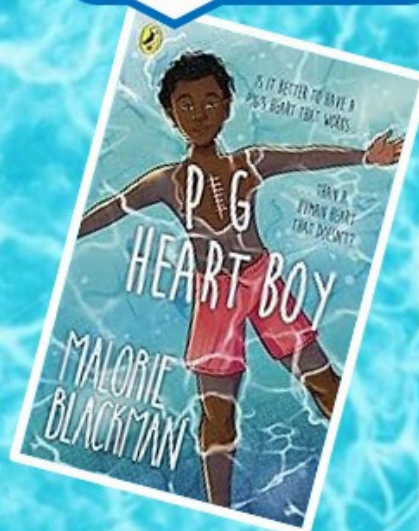
Pig Heart Boy by Malorie Blackman

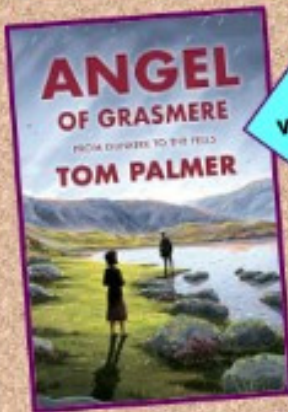

10 POWER OF TEN **HOW TO MAKE AN UPCYCLED T-SHIRT BAG** **10 POWER OF TEN**

Step 1: Take a pre-loved t-shirt and turn it inside out. Cut off the sleeves and lower the neckline as shown.

Step 2: Cut a fringe at the bottom, roughly 2 cm wide and 4 cm upwards.

Step 3: Tie the fringes together, ensuring that there are no holes.

Step 4: Check that the fringes are tight and secure. Add in extra knots if needed.

Step 5: Turn the bag back so that the design is on the outside and the ties are hidden. Now you have a new tote bag!
