As GCSE mock exams approach parents often ask us how they can support their children with revision at home. We would like to invite you to an informal evening about revision on Thursday 17th October which will focus on study skills.

During the evening, there will be a presentation by the Headteacher and Deputy Headteacher outlining what we have to offer here in school in terms of revision sessions. We will also reiterate the messages we are giving to Year 11 students in assemblies – so you will know exactly how your children are being guided.
