The Science Department

The Science Department is the biggest in the school with 15 teaching staff and 3 technicians. It is a very supportive, diverse department with a range of colleagues from early years teachers to very experienced teachers. We would consider applications from any of the Science specialisms, although ideally Physics.

Teaching arrangements for this year are as follows:

Key Stage 3 - We follow the KS3 Activate Scheme. Our aim is to make sure that it allows for rapid progress and teaches students the skills required to be successful in Science as well as the vast amount of knowledge.

Key Stage 4 - We are following the AQA GCSE Combined Science: Trilogy and GCSE Separate Sciences specifications. Students begin these courses in year 9 after Christmas.

Key Stage 5 - Students can choose from AQA's A-level Biology, A-Level Chemistry, A-Level Physics and Edexcel's Level 3 BTEC in Applied Science.

The Science Department is an exciting, forward thinking department which is always at the forefront of any new initiatives. With many student teachers and new staff praising the high level of support that members of the department offer, and the very positive feedback from the students, it is a great place to work.
