We have taken the decision to keep all students in school until Friday 6th June, so that they can receive high-quality, subject specific support from their teachers and also benefit from a short period of study leave as their exams progress. This will be their last formal day of education.

When exams begin, there will be pre-exam briefings before the majority of exams to ensure students are as prepared as possible. Morning pre-exam briefings will begin at 8.30am, so please ensure your child arrives in school promptly with time to spare. Afternoon exam briefings will begin at 12.40pm.

Once exams start, year 11 and year 10 swap dinner times with year 11 taking the early slot.

We have designated Friday 23rd May as the most suitable day for shirt signing. This will take place in Margaret Sewell courtyard during afternoon form period for those who wish to take part. Students are not permitted to sign their shirts before that time as it can be highly disruptive to learning at the most vital time of year.

The official leavers day morning will be on Thursday 19th June. This is where we say goodbye in an informal way, take photos, share memories and wish the students well. Students should arrive in school for 8.45am and are not required to wear school uniform on this day. Breakfast is provided in school.
