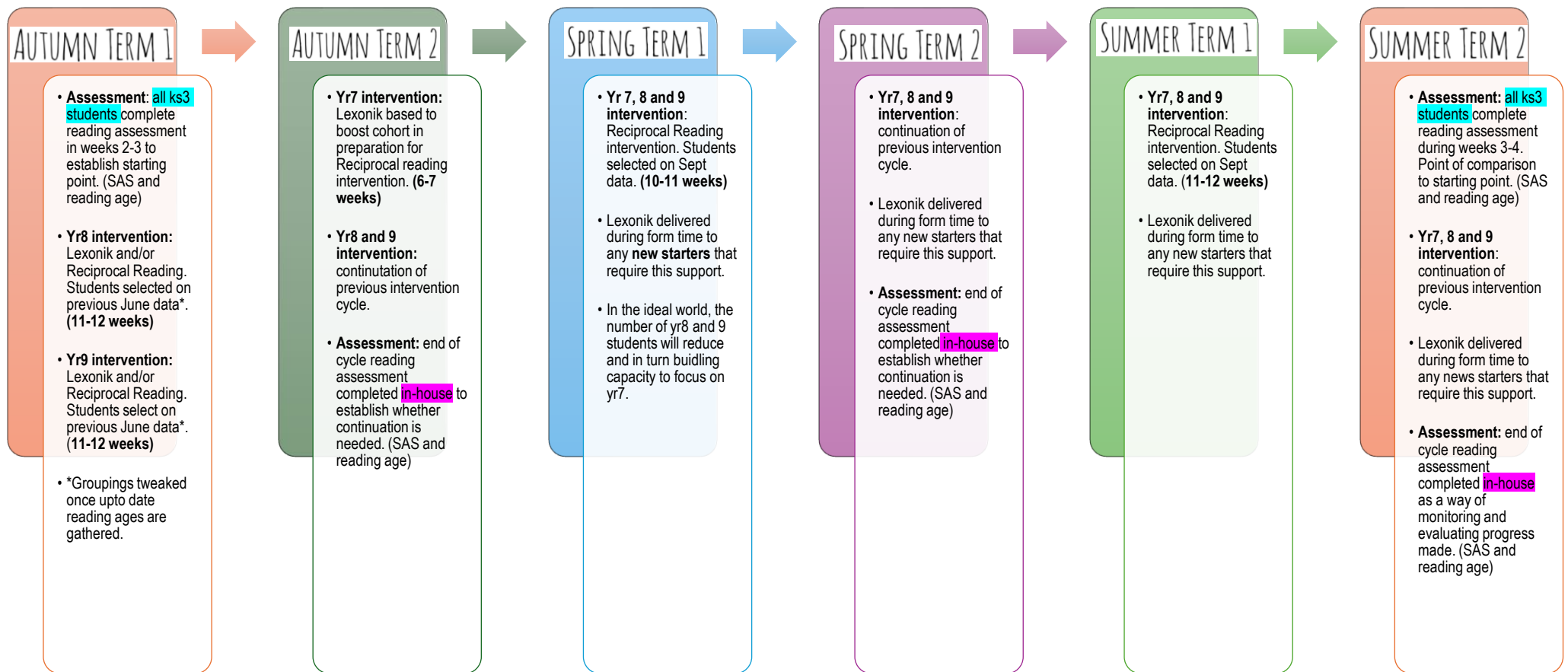


READING INTERVENTION - ACADEMIC YEAR BREAKDOWN



Reading Intervention Additional Notes:

- Literacy assessment online used to complete all forms of reading age testing. If students fall significantly below their reading age (SAS 84 or below), the SEN dept will continue to utilise other forms of assessment.
- In the ideal world, the Autumn term will be used to focus on Lexonik, so that students can then participate in the Reciprocal Reading programme which is what the majority of our students need. However, Lexonik may well be required for new starters throughout the year, particularly EAL students, so this will largely be delivered to smaller groups at this point.
- As we have prior data for yr8 and 9, intervention will be up and running as soon as the new academic year starts. However, yr7 data will not be available until later in the Autumn term. As yr8 and 9 numbers reduce, we will build capacity to focus on the yr7 cohort.
