#### The Music Department

The Music department is staffed by 2 full time music specialists and 7 peripatetic instrumental teachers. All staff are dedicated to providing a rich and engaging music education to students both inside the classroom and through extracurricular activities.

Students in years 7-9 follow a full and varied curriculum and are taught music for 1 hour a week in mixed abilities classes. Topics studied include the Eras of music history, the blues, film music, 4 chord songs, Drill and song writing. The department is well equipped and through their lessons students have the opportunity to use keyboards, guitars, ukuleles and drums as well as music technology through programs such as Bandlab and Sibelius. Students can choose to opt for GCSE music at the end of year 9 and we follow the Eduqas specification for both GCSE and A-Level music.

Outside the curriculum we run a comprehensive extracurricular program which includes a choir, an Orchestra, a chamber ensemble, a brass group, a saxophone group and various student led groups, which currently includes a Jazz Quartet. As well we have various performances throughout the year and the school ensembles also enjoy much success at the local music festival. Once a year we join together with the drama department to put on a whole school production and previous shows have included Les Miserables, Sweeney Todd, We Will Rock You, Hairspray and Legally Blonde.

#### The Post

The post would suit a well-qualified, enthusiastic and experienced musician. The successful candidate will be asked to teach key stage 3 and there could be the opportunity to also teach GCSE and A-Level music for the right candidate. Experience of teaching another performing art subject would be beneficial.
