Dear Parent/Carer

We have been extremely impressed with the effort and attitude of our year 11 students towards their GCSE exams. Their conduct has been excellent.

In addition to pre-exam briefings by subject leaders before exams (in school) time, can we also alert you to three Maths sessions available to students on Thursday 14th May, Wednesday 3rd June and Wednesday 10th June at 8 am. Tea and toast will be available - along with subject staff who can answer questions and help guide students through subject-specific questions; there will also be past papers available. These sessions will be followed by a pre-exam briefing in Creighton Hall as normal.

We have taken the decision to keep all students in school until Friday 5th June, so that they can receive high-quality, subject specific support from their teachers and also benefit from a short period of study leave as their exams progress. This will be their last formal day of education.

We have designated Friday 22nd May as the most suitable day for shirt signing. This will take place in Margaret Sewell courtyard during afternoon form period for those who wish to take part. Students are not permitted to sign their shirts before that time as it can be highly disruptive to learning at the most vital time of year.

The official leavers day morning will be on Thursday 18th June. This is where we say goodbye in an informal way, take photos, share memories and wish the students well. Students should arrive in school for 8.45am and are not required to wear school uniform on this day. Breakfast is provided in school.
