

## **C5 Supervision Room Rules**

*To be read out at the beginning of each one-hour lesson throughout the day and displayed on each student desk*

1. You must follow all expectations set out by the supervising member of staff in this room. The same standards apply as in your classrooms and you must not do anything which could cause disruption or interrupt learning for either yourself or other students.
2. If you need to use the toilet please ask the member of staff supervising- the rules for toilet breaks are the same as for lessons- staff will use professional discretion as to when you can go and you are expected to go directly there and back.
3. You may complete the work you have brought with you or ask for a reading book, work pack or resources. If you require more work or a reading book, please put your hand up and wait – DO NOT shout out.
4. Until you complete this day successfully, you will not be allowed back into your lessons.
5. If this is your C5 day and you arrived here on time this morning and do not reach a C4, you will remain in this room until pm.
6. If you were late this morning or had to be brought here from lessons this morning but you avoid a C4 then then you are here until 3.40pm.
7. If you receive a C4 in this room, this means you do an additional 35 minutes after school tonight in this room and stay until 3.40pm.
8. If you receive a C5 in this room, this means you do your day in this room again from the beginning when you return to school tomorrow (this is a C5B).
9. If you have been sent here from a Good Neighbour venue or by a member of staff, you will remain here until the end of the lesson and then you will be booked in all day tomorrow.
10. It's better for you to stay in the Seclusion Room, complete your day as quickly as you can so that you can return to lessons with your friends, and with teachers who can help you to progress your learning.
