Christmas at Trinity School

We have a number of activities taking place in school in the last week of term to celebrate Christmas and want to keep you informed of events so that students know what is going on and know what to bring to school if they are involved in proceedings.

- The annual Carol Service takes place on **Monday 19th December**. You can find details on the website.
- Students will be involved in a Christmas service on **Friday 16th December** during form time. This will operate as a live streamed event in form rooms like the Remembrance Service.
- Students in Year 7 (only) will be involved in our nativity event during Period 1 on **Wednesday 14th December**. They will need to bring their costumes to school on that day but must come in school uniform. We will let students know what to expect and costumes can be simple – a white sheet and a tinsel halo is absolutely fine!
- There are various reward treats and activities in school taking place to say well done to those students that have shown an excellent approach to learning.
- On **Tuesday 13th (Key Stage 3) and Wednesday 14th (Key Stage 4) December**, the dining facilities are serving Christmas lunch.
- On **Tuesday 20th December** students are allowed to wear non-uniform. Students are asked to pay a contribution of £1. The charity chosen by students this year is Macmillan Cancer support. The dress code for the non-uniform day is the same as sixth form, so no cropped tops or shorts – Christmas jumpers and tinsel are recommended instead! Note that school finishes early on the final day of term and students will begin to be dismissed from 12:15pm.
- Also on **Tuesday 20th December**, students will take part in a Christmas Fayre, with forms choosing to have stalls to raise money for charity. Students will need to bring a small amount of money, preferably in change, if they wish to visit the stalls and buy items.



We are collecting donations for the foodbank through our advent calendar that keeps on giving, as we did last year. Items need to be brought to school as soon as possible to enable collection by the Foodbank. Student will be told about the attendance prize draws which take place in the final week of term, starting on Wednesday 14th December.
