

## **Form Time Information**

There will be two registration periods every day during which each form group will spend time with their Form Tutor.

A brief morning registration period starting at 8.30 will allow tutors to check that students are ready to learn. Regular equipment and uniform checks will take place and any issues addressed before students proceed to their lessons. At this time, essential news and notices for the day ahead will also be shared with students. In the early stages of the year, this will also be an opportunity for tutors to remind students of key expectations and direct them to their first classroom.

The longer registration period at the end of the day will allow for one Year Group assembly per week and more input from tutors on the remaining days. Form Tutors will lead sessions linked to the Thought for the Week themes that will vary throughout the year. The themes are chosen by our Chaplain and linked to the school's Christian values of Community, Hope, Trust, Endurance and Compassion. A typical session may include watching a clip such as the recent example that can be seen [here](#) followed by opportunities for reflection and a class discussion. Other registration periods will address themes that are key to your child's welfare in school - and beyond - such as mental health, wellbeing and e-safety, with chances for tutors to offer guidance and for students to share their views.

The end-of-day registration period also gives the pastoral team the opportunity to address with students any discipline issues that may have arisen during the day to endeavour to pre-empt future issues on their return to school the next day.
