The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can.
- Ensure high levels of hygiene and cleaning throughout the school buildings
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs.
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19.
- Follow the government and health authority guidance if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' have tested positive for COVID-19
- Keep you well informed of the school's procedures during the pandemic through school comms, newsletters, text, email and the school website.
- Develop a clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for students as set out in the COVID Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement.
- Maintain our high level of pastoral care and safeguarding
- Have plans in place for local or national lockdowns that ensure home learning is seamless and progression in learning

Parent

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- **If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.**
- I will not enter the school premises without an appointment and will abide by the 2m rule when visiting school or dropping off my child.
- I will make sure that my child is punctual to school and arrives at the correct time for their 'bubble.'
- I will ensure that my child brings the correct equipment to school on a daily basis, including hand sanitiser, and understand that he/she cannot share with others
- I will remind my child about social distancing and encourage them to socialise with a consistent group of friends
- I will get in touch if I am concerned about my child's wellbeing
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I will keep my contact details up to date.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, I will support the school's recommendations for improving the situation
- I understand that my child will remain in their 'bubble' and cannot mix with other groups.
- I will provide a face covering if required during a local lockdown, for example, and make sure my child understands the rules for removing, storing and washing it
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- I understand that, should school be unable to provide safe staffing ratios or a safe environment as outlined in our risk assessment, school may need to close at short notice.
- I understand that the school is unable to remove all risks relating to the spread of COVID-19
- I understand that school may need to pass on information as part of the Government 'Track and Trace' program
- I will follow the instructions set out in this agreement as well as any additional instructions sent home via letter or email

Student

I will do my best to follow the school's Covid specific behaviours:

- No chewing gum
- No touching
- 2m rule where you can, but always from adults
- Stay in your friendship groups, avoid mixing
- Bring your own equipment – no sharing!
- Look after your workspace, wipe it down
- Stay out of the teacher zone
- Stay seated, stay in your bubble
- No wandering- class, corridors, school
- Obey all instructions from staff or on signs
- Wash your hands, use sanitiser
- Catch it, kill it, bin it
- Stay home if ill with symptoms and get a test
- If you feel ill in school, tell someone
- Follow rules on face coverings

Main symptoms

The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- **high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)



If a child presents with **any** Coronavirus symptoms, however mild, the child will be sent home

By sending your child to Trinity School, we will presume consent to this agreement and that you have agreed to follow government guidance on staying alert and safe.
