Sixth Form Induction Programme

Thursday 5 July 8:30am - 3:15pm

Lunch will be available to purchase. Trinity students must bring their ID cards for identification around school and to access the cashless catering system. New students will be issued with a temporary ID card onto which they can load money to purchase lunch. A typical meal costs around £2.00.

<p><i>*Appropriate length can be judged by using the length of your arm as it is held down by the side of the body to the tip of the middle finger – anything shorter is inappropriate</i></p> <p><i>Students should seek advice from a member of the Sixth Form Team if they are unclear about what is/isn't acceptable, and in particular before making any changes to hair colour/visible piercings.</i></p>
