The resources are from the Anna Freud National Centre for Children and Families who have undertaken research about different ways to look after your wellbeing.

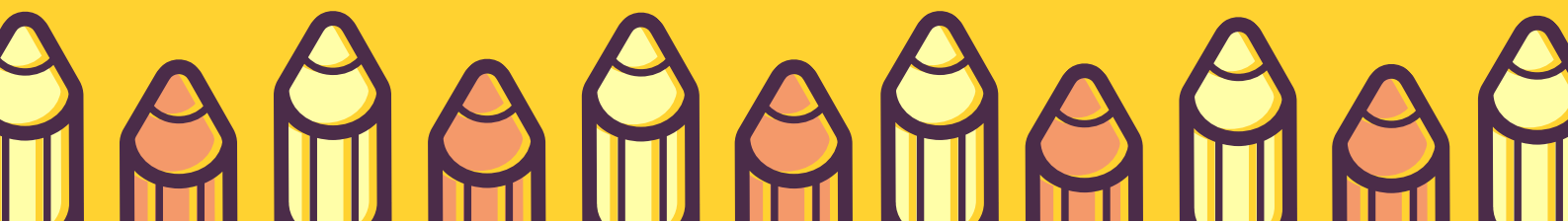

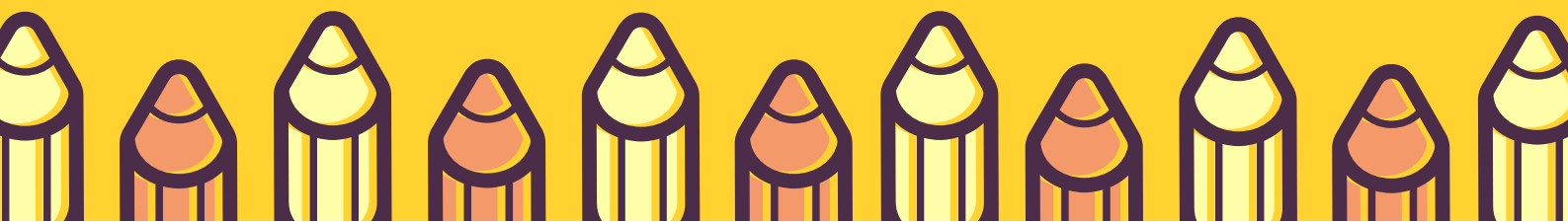
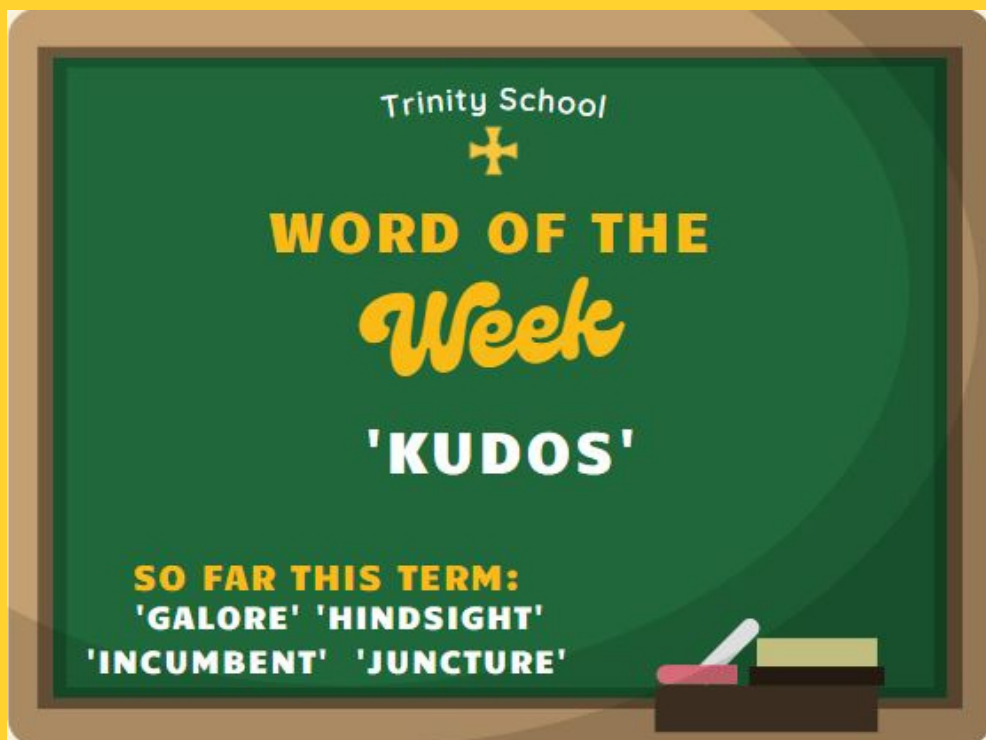
Food and Litter

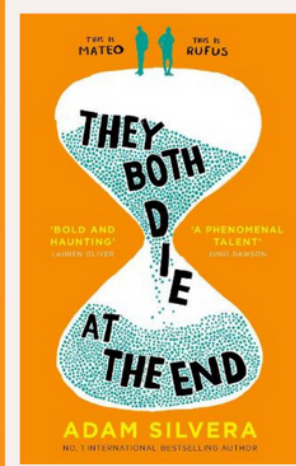
