Dear Parents /Carers,

Industrial action – Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May

The date of the next industrial action is next week. There is a second day of action in the week after this. Based on the numbers of staff in school on the last day of the strike action, school will operate in the same way as previous strikes, with exam groups as the priority for in school teaching.

To remind you, this means that students in Year 11, 12 and 13 are expected to be in school. We have been able to secure more supply staff this time so, alongside members of the Senior Leadership Team, we are anticipating that will be able to cover all Year 11 lessons without the need for doubling up or private study. All students in these year groups are expected to attend school as normal at 8:30am. As before, Year 12 and 13 will need to ensure they have enough work to do during any lessons that are disrupted. Mr Brentnall will confirm arrangements for students in the Home Group and pastoral staff will do the same for vulnerable students.

School will finish at 2:30pm and any students that use a school bus can wait in school until 3:05pm, if required.

For students not in school, the procedure stays the same - a mixture of online lessons via Teams and work set centrally will be available. Teachers will email classes by 8:30am if a lesson is taking place. If they have not received an email from their teacher, they should check on the website for links to work and/or ClassCharts. If there are issues with technology, please let us know via the info email or the year team by Tuesday 25th April and we can provide paper copies of work in advance.

As before normal catering services will operate for students, and vouchers will be provided for the year groups at home who have free school meals.

I would again like to apologise for the disruption caused.
