Dear Parent/Carer

In response to a number of students asking to show their support for the people of Ukraine, we plan to hold a day of fundraising on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> March. Students will be able to come into school wearing blue and yellow items of clothing and may donate a suggested amount of £1 on their way into school. For any students that feel uncomfortable wearing non uniform in school, we have suggested that they can come into school in uniform but add blue and yellow items to their uniform for the day. All the money raised will go to the Disasters Emergency Committee (DEC) Ukraine Appeal.

Some students have decided to raise money at lunchtime and, to enable them to act as courageous advocates, we will have form group stalls at lunchtime for students to get creative in raising money. This event is being organised by Mr Burdon, the Chaplain, Mrs Trevorrow and Form Tutors. If students have new and unusual ideas, they should discuss this with their tutor in the first instance. Students will be able to purchase items on the day from the student stalls and will need to bring a small amount of money if they wish to participate.

We have discussed the events in Ukraine with students through Thought for the Week and assemblies to make sure that they can make sense of what they have seen in the media and will continue to support them in supporting children in other parts of the world. This week Art Club have decorated parts of the school with hand made yellow and blue flowers, just one of the ways that we are seeing our students show their kindness and compassion.

If cases of COVID-19 rise further, we may need to cancel this event at short notice. We will, of course, take all precautions, such as limiting numbers in the hall and asking students to wear a mask for the short time they mix with other year groups.
